CAMPER INFORMATION

Key Deposit:

All campers staying on campus must have a \$50 key deposit at check-in (checks payable to PSA) in order to get their dorm keys. The check will be returned at check-out when the key is returned. This is required because the VT Housing Dept charges a \$50 fee for lost keys.

Camp Soccer Ball:

All campers need a ball at camp. If you would like to purchase a hand-stitched Virginia Tech logo ball for \$25 you need to do so when registering. If registering online you will be asked if you'd like a ball. If you are submitting an application by mail please check that you'd like to purchase a ball and include the \$25 cost with your payment. SIZE 5 BALLS ONLY!

Extra t-shirts:

Extra t-shirts, with a different design than the camp t-shirt, will be available for purchase. To pre-purchase, please check the box on the registration form either online or via paper application. The cost of the extra t-shirts are \$13.

Roommate Requests:

Overnight campers should indicate their roommate request when you register for camp. If you want to ensure you will be placed together you both should request each other when registering. There are only two campers per room. If you are coming with a team we will do our best to place your team next to each other in the dorm.

Safety and Security:

Extra security measures are in place to provide a safe living/camp environment while staying on the campus of Virginia Tech. Dorms are locked throughout the entire day and cannot be accessed without a key card. Key cards are issued to each camper and staff member. Each dorm room has a phone, which provides free local calls and can connect with the local 911 system in an emergency. Finally, the dorm staff rooms are clearly marked for camper needs at all hours. If you have further questions please contact our office.

Camp Evaluations:

Each Advanced & Elite 125 camper will receive a written evaluation from their academy coach at the end of the week.

Arrivals:

Day Camp - attendees will arrive on the 16th at 9:00am for registration. Each day camper should be picked up and dropped off at Rector Field House.

Advanced & Elite 125 Academies – registration will be held in Cassell Coliseum for both overnights and commuters on the first day of camp, beginning at 2:30pm. As a tip, please have balances paid and medical forms complete and turned in prior to registration day. This will allow for a smoother and quicker process. We will have staff members passing out parking passes, in the circle drive off of Spring road, to registrants beginning at 2:15pm to allow registrants to park in designated lots. PSA will not be responsible for tickets given that day.

Departure:

Day Camp – attendees will be picked up in the field house and MUST be signed out by a parent. If a camper is to be picked up by someone other than a parent, please send a note to that effect. The camp ends with a pizza party at 11:15am on the 20th and ends by noon.

Advanced & Elite 125 Academies - end with morning games on the final day. Check out for all overnights will take place after the games in the dormitories, usually between 10:00 and 11:00am. Commuters will check out from the fields.

Medical Forms:

Medical Forms can be downloaded from our website, www.vtsocccercamp.com. These forms must be filled out completely, and must have a doctor's signature on them. In lieu of a camp physical, you may attach a school physical that has taken place within the calendar year! If forms are not filled out completely or do not have the doctor's signature, they will be returned to be completed. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Medical Staff:

Certified trainers (ATC) will provide medical supervision 24 hours a day. If there is specific medical attention that your daughter needs, please have documentation with you to hand to our trainers. Please feel free to call prior to camp to discuss any unique situations.

Lost/Stolen Items:

PSA, is not responsible for campers personal items that are lost or stolen. It is highly recommended that each camper lock their room when they leave. It is also the responsibility of the camper to keep track of their soccer ball as they cannot be replaced by the PSA.

Camper Cars:

Campers that drive themselves to camp must turn their keys into to the director during registration. Keys will be returned at check-out. We will provide parking permits for campers who have cars.

Cancellations/Transfers

Cancellations must be requested in writing to receive a voucher for the 2009 Premier Soccer Academy or a refund. Cancellation requests due to illness or injury must be accompanied by a doctor's note. ALL refunds will be less a \$75 administrative fee. Players who cancel within two weeks prior to camp will only be eligible for a voucher, not a refund. Vouchers for 2008 will be honored in 2009, although you will have to pay the difference between the voucher value and the 2009 session price.

Camp registrations are non-transferable to other camps here at Virginia Tech.

What's Included:

Day campers receive a t-shirt, certificate of completion, and a pizza party on the final day.

Advanced Academy camper will receive t-shirt, lodging and meals, written evaluation and training for 5 days.

Elite 125 campers will receive a t-shirt, lodging and meals, written evaluation and training for the 5 days. Elite 125 campers also get to experience seminars throughout the week.

Commuters receive the same as the advanced and elite except they do not receive breakfast each day.
